Will Job Honour God?

Key Text:

¹¹ "But stretch out your hand and touch all that he has, and he will curse you to your face."

Bible Reading: Job (1:1-12) 2:1 - 10 [ESV]

2:1 Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord, and the challenger also came among them to present himself before the Lord.

2 And the Lord said to the challenger, "From where have you come?" the challenger answered the Lord and said, "From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking up and down on it."

3 And the Lord said to the challenger, "Have you considered my servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, who fears God and turns away from evil? He still holds fast his integrity, although you incited me against him to destroy him without reason."

4 Then the challenger answered the Lord and said, "Skin for skin! All that a man has he will give for his life. 5 But stretch out your hand and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will curse you to your face."

6 And the Lord said to the challenger, "Behold, he is in your hand; only spare his life."

7 So the challenger went out from the presence of the Lord and struck Job with loathsome sores from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head. 8 And he took a piece of broken pottery with which to scrape himself while he sat in the ashes.

9 Then his wife said to him, "Do you still hold fast your integrity? Curse God and die."

10 But he said to her, "You speak as one of the foolish women would speak. Shall we receive good from God, and shall we not receive evil?"

In all this Job did not sin with his lips.
