Text: Job 29 - 31

Key Idea:

In an effort to extract a public vindication from God, Job swears an oath of innocence.

Key Text: Job 30:19-21

God has cast me into the mire,
and I have become like dust
and ashes.

I cry to you for help

and you do not answer me;

I stand,

and you only look at me.

You have turned cruel to me;
with the might of your hand
you persecute me.

Job 30:16-23 [ESV]

- 16 “And now my soul is poured out within me;
days of affliction have taken hold of me.
- 17 The night racks my bones,
and the pain that gnaws me takes no rest.
- 18 With great force my garment is disfigured;
it binds me about like the collar of my tunic.
- 19 God has cast me into the mire,
and I have become like dust and ashes.
- 20 I cry to you for help and you do not answer me;
I stand, and you only look at me.
- 21 You have turned cruel to me;
with the might of your hand you persecute me.
- 22 You lift me up on the wind; you make me ride on it,
and you toss me about in the roar of the storm.
- 23 For I know that you will bring me to death
and to the house appointed for all living.

Job 31:35-37 [ESV]

- 35 Oh, that I had one to hear me!
(Here is my signature! Let the Almighty answer me!)
Oh, that I had the document written by my adversary!
- 36 Surely I would carry it on my shoulder;
I would bind it on me as a crown;
- 37 I would give him an account of all my steps;
like a prince I would approach him.
